The annual brightening of the Taranaki winter by the varied exhibition of art and craft by regional artists and craft workers has become a local tradition, and one which each year shows its unique regional character. It is not simply a matter of knowing that each year the mountain which dominates the province will have appeared in one form or another in many submissions; the regional note is struck more profoundly these days, with works which deal with deeper issues of land and economy.

As in other years, this year's submissions covered a wide range of media and technique, and moved from traditional to radical approaches. The decision to maintain the art and craft combination was again vindicated in the rich variety of the exhibition itself.

The Gallery wishes to thank, once again, the generous sponsors of the exhibition, the Taranaki Savings Bank. The awards given by the Bank are among the most substantial for any regional art competition, and, at a regional level, give incentive and encouragement to artists and craft workers who have not yet reached the attention of the national market.

Our thanks also go to this year's selection panel, Jean Hastedt, Andrew Drummond and Ian Wedde. Although the selection process was carried out in less than ideal circumstances this year, because of the renovation work going on in the Gallery, the panel worked carefully and thoughtfully through the large number of submissions, and provided us with a considered group of award winners and exhibitors.

It was a disappointment to Gallery staff that this year's TSB Review could not be, as planned, the first exhibition to take advantage of the vastly improved public amenities of the renovated service, administration and education areas of the Gallery. However we thank the artists who submitted work, whether or not it was selected, for their forbearance, and hope that we will continue to enjoy their support and their enthusiasm for their craft, without which neither this exhibition nor the Gallery itself could survive.
