## TSB REVIEW

Govett Brewster Art Gallery Queen st New Plymouth 28 July 21 August

A generous impulse to share the pleasure of their interested participation in the visual arts must be the reason for the great number of works submitted for the Review by Taranaki people. Almost all submissions were presented with a sense of pride, if the fortune spent in framing is any indication. The assessors, sensible of the need for a compact and qualitatively representative Review exhibition, could not match this generosity.

A general criticism of much of the work submitted is that a display of growing technical skill in any medium is not of itself meritorious. Even lesser skills are acceptable if ideas and creative intentions are present in the work. Moreover, in the two-dimensional work that basic substructure - drawing - was so often lamentable and no amount of textural activity could save the day. So to admit to the exhibition such a diversity of attitudes and levels of competence there had to be the always fallible, though I hope fair, assessment of how a work measured up in "perceived" intention, in the evidence of personal vision as opposed to the slavish copying of a trite model and, where appropriate, a controlled economy of means.

The best works in this Review, here as elsewhere the minority of the show, would hold their own in any company in the country. They are obviously the product of a tougher and more learned acquaintance with the visual arts disciplines and ideologies, as they eschew self-indulgent distractions and spurious stimuli. These models of individual creative substance should be attended and studied by the rest of those who, selected or not, submitted work for the Review. Certainly here was an added pleasure for those assessors privileged to select this Review.


