TSB REVIEW 1984

The Taranaki Savings Bank Review 1984 is the third all craft exhibition of this annual event. Total number of entries was down on previous craft reviews and this is disappointing. However, this could possibly reflect an appreciation by craftspeople of the standard expected for the exhibition now known as the TSB Review.

There are obvious omissions such as Maori arts and crafts which are poorly represented, as are wood carvers, embroiderers and a number of other crafts, groups and individuals. Enthusiasm and participation are the key to all successful exhibitions and it is hoped this will be apparent in the next such Review.

As in the past, the selection process was careful, considered and tough. The criteria for selection was simply quality of function, design, technical skill and aesthetics. Generally, technical expertise was the strongest factor in most work, reflecting the overall level of competence. Design quality - originality, imagination and creativity - was the weakest. This, in turn, reflects the local need for considerably more formal tuition in basic design skills and appreciation.
