I believe the anachronism of contemporary New Zealand education is its 1950's emphasis on the written word when the daily realities of this decade is the flood of visual eniticement and trickery with which our children are expected to cope. Visual literacy is a tool for today's survival. It can be taught much as English (verbal literacy) is taught - its current idioms, historical forms, constructions and variations, uses and misuses. We don't expect every English student to become a writer, but we do expect him to understand the forms and functions of his language.

Equally then, all students should be able to critically interpret their visual environment, the symbols of the street, directional signs, commercial graphics, magazine and T.V. ads, posters, prints, photographs, theatre and movies and contemporary art. The art gallery can play a major role in the development of visual education with its changing exhibitions and presentations. The Govett-Brewster Art Gallery is rapidly expanding its extension and education programmes to meet this challenge with Gallery tours, slide lectures, practical workshops for both students and teachers, holiday programmes, family-centred art and craft workshops and of course, annual exhibitions of school children's art, such as this one.
