The Govett-Brewster Art Gallery and its associates in this venture, the Taranaki Savings Bank, are to be congratulated for taking the risk of inviting three outsiders and its Director to make judgments on the state of the Art of the Art of Craft in Taranaki.

The selection process was careful and considered, the criteria for selection were tough. The exhibition chosen is small and the selectors hope it reflects the best of what is happening in the crafts in Taranaki.

What was looked for was technical assurance that married well with a freshness of approach. Works were sought that had a spark of magic that took them beyond the realm of the ordinary. Not all the works chosen have the power necessary to make them into works of art in their own right, but viewers are urged to seek out those works that possess ingredients that communicate beyond their surface form.

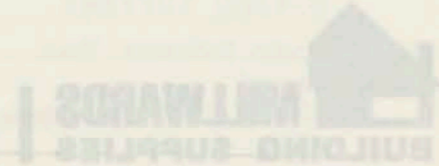
